## **b.** Senate Speaker

**i.** Prince opens floor for nominations

- Bryz-Gornia entertains motion to nominate Lundborg
- Loose nominated Lundborg, Thayer seconds
- Fogelberg nominated by Henrickson, seconded by Hahn
- **ii.** Lundborg: On Senate for four years with Senate and Cabinet. Can work within Cabinet; experienced. Will be strong voice for senators on campus, has a good feel for issues and is available.
  - Kampfe asks: How do you plan to increase interaction between senate and cabinet?
  - Lundborg: Will be very available and posted in senate office, excellent at email correspondence
  - Nelson: Will you speak to Cabinet on a macro or micro issue level?
  - Lundborg: He will handle bot micro and macro issues appropriately
  - Hahn: How do you plan to improve senate relations with the DLC and other groups?
  - Lundborg: Will defer to people who have more experience; utilize the connections of the people who can best help the organizations.
- **iii.** Fogelberg: Same as Lundborg, except three years instead of four. It would be an ideal position to work with Cabinet but to still have voice heard. Political Science Major.
  - Kampfe: How do you plan to increase interaction between senate and cabinet?
  - Fogelberg: Greatest way to improve relations are interactions outside of the boardroom. Utilize senate office for social reasons an general gettogethers.
  - Coco: How will you deal with the DLC, with me being a Cabinet member and the DLC rep
  - Fogelberg: Will make sure Coco's voice is heard in her other role. Will try to make relationship less tense. No where to go but up.
  - Hahn: How will you increase transparency for benefit of other organizations?
  - Work with PR chair to help people realize that By-laws and constitution are available online to public. Work with Finance chair, since that is often how clubs interact with senate.
  - Prince: clarifies position: does not mean speaker is the public voice of senate, more that the speaker represents the senators with the cabinet
