The Student Senate meeting on Monday the 14th began with the appointments of representatives for the off-campus and Arborview positions. Greta Gray, a senior Gustavus Student, was appointed to serve as the Off-Campus Representative, and Kevin Bonnema was appointed to serve as the Arborview Representative. The next order of business was a midyear request from the Women's Awareness Center. An amount of money was allocated to the WAC to aid in the speaker fee for the homelessness benefit speaker that will be brought to campus on November 18th. Senate moved to new business where a resolution was passed to move forward with plans for the Dive renovation and also intend to select and hire an architectural design firm to propose design options for the renovation. A vote passed for a streets committee to be formed with Andrei Hahn as the chair. The intent of this committee is to address campus concerns involving parking situations, new options for public expression of students, and other future charges to this committee.

Congratulations to Greta Gray, who was elected the Student Senate Off-Campus Representative, and to Kevin Bonnema, who was elected the Student Senate Arborview Representative.
